April focused on strengthening systems, improving operations, and creating a stronger academic foundation.



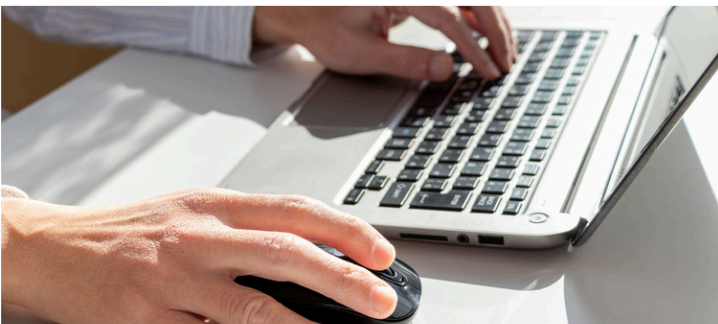
### TEACHER INDUCTION & TRAINING

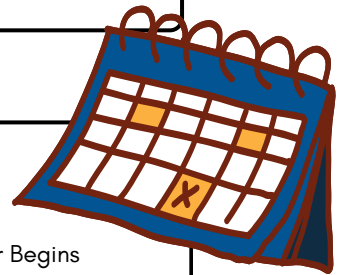
